

FAIRFIELD SKATE PARK

To keep it open and safe, follow these rules

1. Respect the neighborhood. Park hours are as follows:

School Year	Summer & School Breaks
Mon. – Fri. 4 pm – 8 pm or dark	Mon.–Sun. 10 am – 8 pm or dark
Sat. & Sun. 10 am – 8 pm or dark	

Park will be closed the months of November through February

2. Call 419-897-7000 to unlock or secure the facility.
3. No bicycles or glass in or around the skate area. Keep food, drink and litter off the skate surface. Use trash containers where provided.
4. No alcohol, tobacco, drugs, loud music or profanity are permitted. Fighting will not be tolerated.
5. Skate at your own risk. Know your ability and skate within them.
6. Safety equipment is strongly recommended. Younger children are at greater risk and should wear helmets and arm/knee pads when using this facility. Shirts must be worn at all times.
7. Children 10 and under should be supervised by an adult who is at least 18 years of age.
8. Additional obstacles or other materials (ramps, jumps) may not be used.
9. Spectators should watch from outside the skate area.
10. Do not use this facility if a hazardous condition exists [rain, snow, ice, and darkness]. Report damage to the Department of Public Service at (419) 897-7150
11. All organized events must have written approval from the City of Maumee prior to the event.
 - The Skate Park is an unsupervised facility, any use of this facility is at your own risk
 - Skateboarding and skating are recreational activities. Use of this facility may result in serious injury.
 - Anyone found not following the fore-stated rules shall be grounds for park closure.
