

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of labor and materials for the construction of: Cass Road Sanitary Sewer Pumping Station Improvements for the City of Maumee will be received by the City of Maumee, Director of Public Service in the Municipal Building, 400 Conant Street, Maumee, Ohio 43537-3379, until **9:00 AM, EASTERN STANDARD TIME on Thursday, August 10, 2017**. No late bids, FAX bids or electronic copies will be accepted. The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the office of the Consulting Engineer, Stantec Consulting Services Inc., 4540 Heatherdowns Boulevard, Suite A, Toledo, Ohio 43614 (419-380-8910). A bid set may be obtained at the office of the Consulting Engineer on or after Thursday, July 20, 2017, at a cost of \$50.00, or \$60.00 if requested to mail. Bid documents are also on file for review at the City of Maumee Department of Public Service and Builders Exchange, 5555 Airport Highway, Toledo, Ohio 43615.

All bids shall be submitted in the original bound bid document. Bids will only be received from registered planholders. Each bidder is required to furnish its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. In lieu of posting the bond, a bidder may use a Cashier's Check, Certified Check or Letter of Credit for ten percent of the Contractor's bid as security. When a check or letter of credit is used, the bidder shall be required to post a 100 percent Performance Bond upon signing the contract. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of experience on projects of similar size and complexity by means of prequalification requirements.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Lucas County as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Divisions, and per Ohio Revised Code Section 4115.

Ohio Revised Code Section 3517.13(I) and (J) requires that no agency or department of this state or any political subdivision shall enter into any contract for the purchase of goods costing more than five hundred dollars or services costing more than five hundred dollars with a corporation, individual, partnership, or other unincorporated business, association, including, without limitation, a professional organization organized under Chapter 1785 of the Revised Code, estate, or trust unless the contract includes a certification that the individuals named in Revised Code Sections 3517.13(I) and (J) are in compliance with the aforementioned provisions. The bidder is required to complete the affidavit provided. Failure to submit the required form with the proposal/bid package could deem the bidder's response to be non-responsive and disqualified from receiving further consideration.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 153.13 and 153.63, for the faithful performance of work under this contract, the successful bidder will be paid at a rate of 92% of the acceptable work completed until the project is 50% completed. The remaining 8% shall be placed in escrow. After the project is 50% complete, payments shall be made at a rate of 100% of the amount of acceptable work completed. The amount placed in escrow shall be released upon final completion of the work under this contract.

Bidders may view the project site by contacting Mr. Doug Riseborough, Superintendent, at 419-897-7190. The project cost is estimated at \$513,100.00.

The City of Maumee may reject all bids per Ohio Revised Code 735.06. The rejection of such shall not result in accrual of any right, claim, or cause of action by any unsuccessful bidder against the City of Maumee. The City of Maumee reserves the right to waive any irregularities in the form of the bid that do not affect or destroy a competitive bidder. In no case will an award be made until all necessary investigations are made as to the qualifications of the bidder to whom it is proposed to award the contract.
